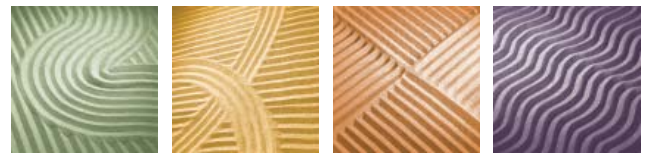

Citizenship and Immigration Canada has announced proposed changes to Canadian Immigration rules. A four-year cumulative limit will be imposed on many temporary foreign workers' employment in Canada. After a four-year work term, they will now have to wait four years before becoming eligible to again work temporarily in Canada. It is therefore in the best interests for both Employers and Employees to take an active interest in finding out when and how foreign workers can apply for Permanent Residency to stay in Canada.

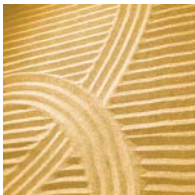
