Notable Matters

- E.T. v Saskatchewan Government Insurance, 2020 SKAIA 37
Represented Saskatchewan Government Insurance in an Automobile Injury Appeal Commission hearing. The Commission found in favor of Saskatchewan Government Insurance and the appeal was denied.
- U.S. v Saskatchewan Government Insurance, 2020 SKAIA 8
- Represented Saskatchewan Government Insurance in an Automobile Injury Appeal Commission hearing to strike an appeal that was filed outside of the limitation period.
- N.H. v Saskatchewan Government Insurance, 2020 SKAIA 21
- Represented Saskatchewan Government Insurance in an Automobile Injury Appeal Commission hearing where it was found that the claimant's ongoing symptoms were not caused by the motor vehicle accident.
- Represented Saskatchewan Government Insurance in an Automobile Injury Appeal Commission hearing wherein Saskatchewan Government Insurance's previous decision letters were upheld.
